### EXHIBIT RULES

All entries in Department J must be grown by the exhibitors during the current year except entries in the classes of 560, 561, and 562 ; which should be from the previous year.

Loose grains and seeds should be displayed in clear quart container, provided by the exhibitor. Bundles should be ready to hang. All fruits and vegetables should be displayed on a 6 inch disposable plate. [\*A larger plate can be used if needed, but should not overly exceed the size of the display]. Vegetable Displays should be self-contained.

Exhibits should be free from dirt. [For example: potatoes washed, corn husked, onions brushed but not peeled, dry skins removed, etc.] No waxes, oils or polishes on fruits or vegetables.

Specimens should be displayed in clear glass soda bottles, half-pint, pint, or quart containers.

All Floral arrangements and displays must be completely self-contained and must use real flowers. Dried or artificial flowers may be added, but should not be the focal point.

## HANGING ARTWORK

**ADULT ARTWORK** must be framed and ready to hang on PEGBOARD HOOKS. Works will be disqualified if they can not be hung. **NO FLAT HANGERS OR STRING AND TAPE WILL BE ALLOWED.**

**HIGH SCHOOL, MIDDLE SCHOOL AND GRADE SCHOOL ARTWORK** must be mounted on construction paper or poster board. With a minimum of a one inch border. No framed works, foam core or canvases will be accepted.
